## WHAT IS IT?

Extreme Event is an in-person game played in groups. Players must work together to solve problems during an engaging, fast-paced disaster simulation.

Besides being fun, the game helps people think about how we can work together as individuals, communities, and a nation to build disaster resilience.

Players learn how important it is to build coalitions across all sectors of a community and invest in short-term and long-term resources to make their city more resilient. Use it for:
